MOST HOLY ONE TRIUNE GOD

The Bible tells us that God is living and personal, profoundly close to us in creating and sustaining us. Though he is totally other, hidden, glorious and wondrous, he communicates himself to us through creation and reveals himself through the prophets and above all in Jesus Christ, whom we meet in the Church, especially in Scripture and the sacraments.

Mystery of God is a reality too rich to be fully grasped by our minds, so that while it continues to unfold, it always remains beyond our comprehension. God has shown himself to us throughout the history of salvation. He is ultimately experienced by human beings through his Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.

God is the Trinity. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of the Christian life. (CCC 261). We profess our faith in God as "Father almighty." His fatherhood and power illuminate each other by his care for us, by adopting us as sons and daughters in Baptism and by being rich in mercy to forgive our sins. Jesus revealed God as *Father* in a new sense. God is Father in his relation to Jesus, his only begotten Son. The Son is divine, as is the Father (cf. Mt. 11:27). Jesus is the Second Person of the blessed Trinity, conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. Jesus is true God and true man. (CCC 464). Jesus is the Savior of all. The Book of the Acts of the Apostles teaches: *There is no salvation through anyone else, nor is there any other name under heaven given to the human race by which we are to be saved.* (Acts. 4:12). The name *Jesus* means "God saves."

Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit as teacher, guide, and consoler. The Spirit's appearance at Pentecost and other events in the New Testament gives ample evidence of the Holy Spirit as the third Person of the Trinity. He is equal in being with the Father and the Son, of the same divine nature as they are (*consubstantial* with them).

The Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son.
